No. SEOC/DRR&DM-01/2011-12 **In exercise of the powers conferred under section 14(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to Re-constitute the STATE DISASTER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (hereinafter called the State Authority) with immediate effects as follows:-**

State Disaster Management Authority (SDMA)



Term of the Authority shall be for a period of 3 (three) years.

Power & Functions of the State Authority shall be as follows:-

1. Preparation of Policies & Plans for Disaster Management in the State of Arunachal Pradesh.
2. Approval of State Disaster Management Policy and Plans in accordance with guidelines laid down by the National Disaster Management Authority.
3. Approval of Disaster Management plans prepared by departments of Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh.
4. Lay down guidelines to be followed by the Departments of Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh for the purposes of measures for prevention of disasters and mitigation in their development programmes and provide necessary assistance thereof.
5. Coordinate the implementation of State Plan.
6. Recommend for provision of funds for mitigation and preparedness measures.
7. Review the development plans of the different departments of Govt. of A.P and ensure that prevention and mitigation measures are integrated therein.
8. Review the measures being taken for mitigation, capacity building and preparedness by the departments of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and issue such guidelines as may be necessary.
9. Lay down detailed guidelines for providing standards of relief to persons affected by disaster in the state of Arunachal Pradesh which shall in no case be less than the minimum standards in the guidelines laid down by the National Disaster Management Authority in this regard.
10. All the power & functions laid down in the National Disaster Management Act,2005 shall be applied.

Further, the Chairperson of the State Authority shall in case of an emergency, have the power to exercise all or any of the State Authority, but exercise of such powers shall be subject to ex-post facto ratification of the State Authority.




